

## Jaz in the City Vienna

Inspired by Vienna's rich musical history, the 163-room Jaz in the City from BWM Architekten immerses guests in the sounds of the city, starting at the check-in desk that doubles as a record store. The music theme continues in the soundproof glass cube in the middle of the lobby, which calls to mind a recording studio; the red-hued niche along the dining room wall that resembles an oversized amplifier; and at the rooftop bar, where paintings of musicians like Elton John and Cher line the wall.

## The Goodtime Hotel Miami Beach

Bringing together the multihyphenate Pharrell Williams, nightlife impresario David Grutman, and the masterful design sense of Ken Fulk, the 166-room Goodtime Hotel is a splashy entrant to the Miami hotel scene. Recalling the opulence of a bygone era, Strawberry Moon swim club and bar channels the midcentury Caribbean and Central American resort towns with broad stripe pastel tiling and vintage scalloped bar seating. Meanwhile, the peach-hued and oak-clad Library is a meeting ground within the hotel, inviting guests to seamlessly transition from work to weekend mode.
