As Europe gears up for summer and its annual influx of holidaymakers, a flurry of new hotels has popped up across the continent to align with their arrival. This month, an Australian aparthotel makes its European debut in Vienna, an Italian chalet hideaway is reborn, and Greece welcomes yet another minimalist boutique bolthole. Across the pond, we have our sights set on exploring Savannah, Georgia and taking some time out at a wellness retreat far away from it all in Joshua Tree. Here are the best new hotels that have caught Wallpaper’s attention this month.

The world’s best new hotel openings

A by Adina Vienna Danube, Austria

A by Adina has brought a touch of the Australian wilderness to the Austrian capital. To mark its European debut, the brand handed the keys to its latest aparthotel to the Vienna-based BWM Designers & Architects, who looked across the world at Australia's vast landscapes to create the nature-inspired interiors. Earthy shades of green, light wood, and artwork by Australian artist Doreen Chapman dress the 120 studios and apartments, which all come with private kitchens, living and dining areas. On the fifth floor, which is where the public spaces can be found, restaurant Lottie's is furnished with warm neutral shades and organic textures of

stone, wood, and glass. There's also a gym and sauna, and outside, an infinity pool with a Vienna view. *NLS*

Aman Rosa Alpina, Italy

Aman's refurbishment of a historic chalet hideaway in San Cassiano is finally complete. The group handed the keys to long-standing collaborator Jean-Michel Gathy, who has respected the property's Alpine heritage by blending traditional timber and stone with contemporary black metal accents. The revamped F&B offering includes an Italian grill, a private wine library, a cigar and spirits lounge, and in the reimagined double-height arrival space, a new bar inspired by the original hotel's piano bar. Of course, this being Aman, there is also a serene spa, with three pools and a treatment menu inspired by the restorative powers of the mountains. A ski

lounge, kids' game room, and three cinemas round out the impressive list of facilities. *NLS*

Municipal Grand, Savannah, USA

Sitting in Savannah's downtown Historic District, the Municipal Grand showcases the contrasting modernist side of the city's better-known antebellum architecture.

AAamp Studio has respected the building's midcentury roots by retaining original features such as grey granite walls, white concrete frames and blue mosaic tiles, but brought a new softness to the otherwise sober design with a suitably retro palette of brown, burgundy and forest green. On the ground floor, large, rounded banquettes sit beside the semi-circular curve of the marble

bar, open for all-day dining and cocktails, whilst outside, the nostalgic Sun Club pool and bar is reserved exclusively for hotel guests. *NLS*

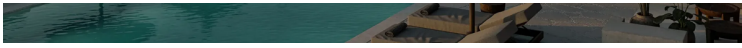

Oku Bodrum

Hotel group Oku has been busy sprinkling its MO of barefoot luxury across Ibiza, Kos and Andalusia and, this summer, it unveils its fourth address on Bodrum's rugged coastline. The adults-only policy delivers sybaritic indulgence – no pitter-patter disrupts morning swims in the pool suspended above the Aegean or afternoon tipples on private terraces overlooking the Mediterranean. AEM Architecture's design, executed with Oku's in-house team, carves 58 rooms into the cliffs, dressing spaces in earthy tones and natural textures such as rattan and oak. This deliberate simplicity extends to Teyo, where chef Mark Vaessen offers a Japanese-meets-global menu. As the day fades, guests gather at the Round Bar, on a jetty above the water, before migrating to The View for gin-based cocktails under the stars. *DW*

Park Hyatt Johannesburg, South Africa

Park Hyatt has brought its signature contemporary style to a 1930s stately mansion in Johannesburg's Rosebank district. The brand has carefully restored the property's original high ceilings, wide verandahs and arches, which open onto a central courtyard and the hotel's heated outdoor pool, and dressed the 31 rooms, cigar lounge, and live fire restaurant Room 32 with a modern yet classic palette of warm neutrals. To pay homage to the country's vast and diverse landscape, the finishing touch is a bespoke collection of nature-inspired South African artwork, which sits alongside a selection of 19th-century botanical illustrations that have been carefully sourced from historical archives.

Reset Hotel, Twentynine Palms, USA

As the name suggests, checking into Hotel Reset is all about doing just that. The natural desert surroundings have informed the hotel's minimalist geometric structure, which has been crafted from raw local materials to blend seamlessly with the dramatic, untouched landscape. Inside the 65 guest rooms, pared-back custom sofas and built-in wall desks simplify each space and allow for a moment of reflection, as well as placing all focus on the mountain views. Communal spaces include the Clubhouse, a co-working space with a café and bar and a communal fire pit, and an outdoor pool framed with cabanas and sweeping views, but guests will also be encouraged to explore the hundreds of acres of desert that surround the hotel through planned art installations and experiences. *NLS*

Tella Thera, Crete, Greece

Nature and sustainability underpin the design of Greece's newest boutique sanctuary, Tella Thera. The organic shapes of Pieris. Architects' minimalist suites blend into the Cretan landscape, quite literally, with each half-buried within the earth and covered with a planted rooftop to help naturally control the temperature. Inside, muted neutral shades, raw materials, and locally crafted furnishings create a sense of calm, enhanced by panoramic Aegean Sea views from the curved and half-moon windows. The Anemoia Restaurant also takes a sustainable approach with a plant-based, minimal waste menu that puts local Cretan ingredients at the forefront. In the wellness area, spa treatments with homemade botanical oils encourage relaxation and rejuvenation and are complemented by time in the sauna, steam room, magnesium pool, and daily yoga classes.
